 - b) Right view of ministry and professional success. (2 marks)
 - c) Right view of wealth and possessions. (2 marks)
 - d) Living simply. (2 marks)
 - e) A life accountability partner. (2 marks)

3. Whereas the higher you go the cooler it becomes, God humbles the proud and exalts the humble. Discuss FIVE disciplines that would enable a leader to practice humility of life without letting their position get in the way. Give practical examples to support your arguments. (10 marks)
4. Appropriate prioritization of the wellbeing of one's family is a key to Authentic Christian Ministry. Discuss this statement with reference to authentic spirituality. Give biblical references to support your answers. (10 marks)
5. Financial propriety is one of the fundamental markers of moral integrity in the life of a Christian leader. Discuss FIVE disciplines that would enable a leader to sustain a life of financial accountability in their personal and professional life. Give relevant contextual examples to support your answers. (10 marks)
6. A leader's success is properly measured by the success of their successor. Discuss this statement with reference to the leader's responsibility to mentor younger leaders. Give examples to support your answers. (10 marks)
