 - (d) Sexual right. (2 marks)
 - (e) Gender role. (2 marks)
- ii) May and Jane have visited your counselling center for help. They indicate that they are Christians and have been married for three years. Their main issue is that they have been experiencing ridicule from their family and friends due to lack of child in their marriage. In the assessment, you found out that May has been engaged in physical infidelity with his former girlfriend while Jan is emotionally attached to a male colleague at her work place. Relating to this case:
- (a) Explain any TWO ethical principles to guide you in this therapy. (4 marks)
 - (b) Discuss ONE social and ONE Psychological cause of sexuality dysfunction in this couple's relationship. (2 marks)
 - (c) Describe TWO ways physical infidelity can hurt this couple's relationship. (2 marks)
 - (d) Briefly discuss TWO ways a church community can prevent occurrences of adultery in the society. (2 marks)
