DEPT. OF COMPUTING & IT HOLD A MEET & GREET EVENT

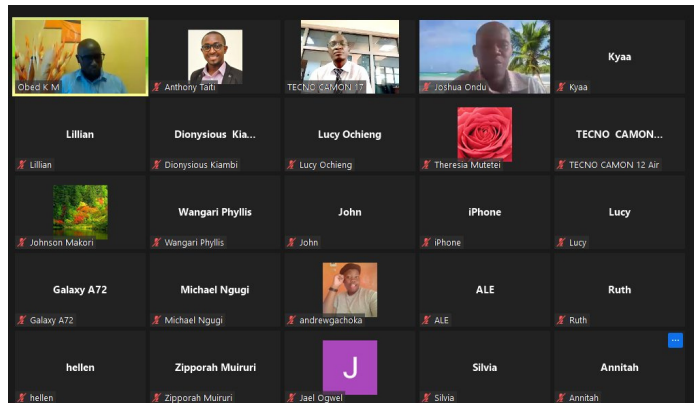
