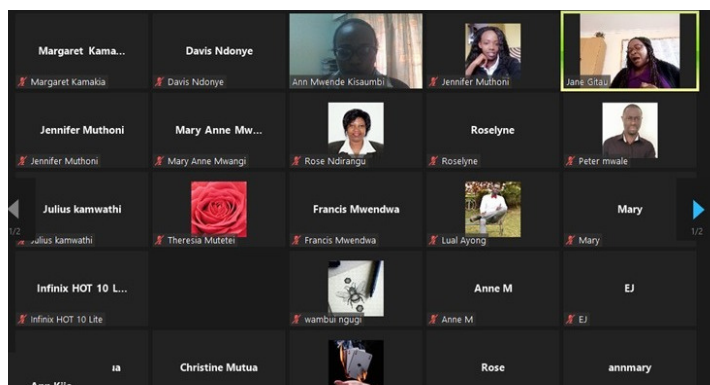

VACANCY FOR THE POSITION OF VICE CHANCELLOR (2023)

Pan Africa Christian (PAC) University is an institution of higher learning chartered by the Commission for University Education (CUE), and sponsored/owned by Christ is the Answer Ministries (CITAM).

The Search Committee of PAC University's Governing Council invites applications from qualified candidates for the position of the **Vice Chancellor**. This strategic leadership position reports to the University's Governing Council.

Minimum Academic Qualifications: At least an Associate Professor or equivalent and a holder of an earned PhD from a university recognized by the CUE.

Minimum Experience: At least twelve (12) years of academic research and leadership experience at a senior level in a university or equivalent institution with demonstrated leadership acumen and possessing the highest level of integrity, morals, competence and institutional commitment.

Other Important Information: Details on duties, responsibilities, contractual period, qualifications, experience, other skills, and competencies required may be found on the following websites: www.pacuniversity.ac.ke/index.php/careers-2/ or at www.citam.org.

How to Apply

- Applicants meeting the above requirements should submit a detailed current CV including academic qualifications, professional experience, records of academic leadership, publications, scholarships, grants and awards, membership in professional associations, and community service;
- Copies of certificates and testimonials should also be provided, along with an email address and telephone contacts;
- Shortlisted candidates will be required to present originals of the following Certificates of Clearance: Clearance from Higher Education Loans Board (HELB); Clearance from the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission (EACC); Clearance from Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA), and; Certificate of good conduct;
- Names, telephone numbers and contact addresses of three referees should be provided;
- Applicants are required to indicate their current or past monthly salary;
- Applications and the referees' confidential report on the applicant's suitability for the position

To effectively manage the transition process of the University's Vice Chancellor next year, the Governing Council's search committee recently advertised the VC's position in the Nation newspaper, inviting qualified candidates to submit applications.
