2. Blessed is a counselor who has been assisting clients recognize their talents and overcome past experiences. State **FOUR** counseling skills she uses to help her clients. (4 Marks)
3. Mr. T sought the services of a counselor to help him adjust to his life after losing his job, during the next session, he would be required to sign a contract with his counselor. State **FOUR** details of a counseling contract. (4 Marks)
4. Counselors don't work with clients forever but for a stipulated time within the contract signed. Analyze **THREE** roles of the counselor during the termination of a contract with the client. (3 Marks)
5. A counselor may refer a client to another counselor during the counseling session or before. Mention **FOUR** reasons why one would refer a client. (4 Marks)
6. Psychosocial support is often overlooked by members of the society who might not understand it. State **FOUR** benefits of psychosocial support in the society. (4 Marks)
7. As a counselor, the management of Daduu company has contracted you to advise them on how to build a healthy working environment which reduces stress for the members of the organization. State **THREE** ways in which the company would achieve this. (3 Marks)
8. Counselling is a process designed to help individuals enhance their wellbeing. Identify **THREE** challenges a client may face during the counselling process. (3 Marks)
9. There are several approaches that a counsellor may choose to utilize while working with clients. State **FOUR** reasons why a counsellor may adopt the humanistic approach during counselling process. (4 Marks)
10. Counselors keep different types of records of clients they are working with at a particular time. State **FOUR** types of client's records kept by counselors. (4 Marks)
11. Preparing a good counselling environment lays the necessary foundation for forming an alliance and building trust. State **THREE** ways a counsellor may ensure minimal destructions during a counselling session. (3 Marks)

12. Sarah is a 30-year-old woman who recently lost her job due to the company downsizing. She has been feeling overwhelmed, anxious, and hopeless about her future. She has neglected her personal hygiene as her self-esteem has declined. Sarah's relationships with her family, friends, church members, neighbors and the village women group have also been strained as she isolates herself more often. She struggles to sleep at night and experiences frequent panic attacks during the day. Sarah has never sought mental health support before but is now considering reaching out for help.
- Analyze **FOUR** psychosocial issues Sarah is facing. (8 Marks)
 - Identify **FOUR** informal support options available to Sarah. (8 Marks)
 - Identify **TWO** gaps that exist in service delivery for individuals like Sarah with mental health challenges. (4 Marks)
13. Safeguarding client's confidentiality during counselling is important because it builds and maintains trust and ensures open and honest communication from the clients. It also plays a major role in developing a rapport with the client.
- Explain **FIVE** ways of ensuring confidentiality of client's information. (10 Marks)
 - Explain **FIVE** ways of exploring client problems. (10 Marks)
14. Social workers take session notes at critical stages of psychosocial support i.e. when the client is narrating their experiences and during exploration of client problem. This helps the counsellor in finding the challenges of the client.
