 - b) Briefly explain what each name or title listed in a) above teaches about the character or ministry of the prophet. (8 marks)
2. Read Jeremiah 11:1-11. Summarize Jeremiah's message to the people of his day and analyze its significance for the society in which you live in today. (10 marks)
3. Using Isaiah as an example, explain how one's call influences his/her ministry. (10 marks)

Section B: Answer ANY THREE questions. (30 marks)

4. Discuss four basic principles or rules of interpretation that the church should use currently in order to understand and apply the message of the Hebrew prophets. (10 marks)
5. In reference to Ezekiel 3: 17-20 and 33:1-16, compare and contrast the duties of Prophet Ezekiel with the evangelistic responsibility of Christians today. (10 marks)
6. Discuss how God helped the Hebrew prophets to fulfill their responsibilities. Give examples. (10 marks)
7. Summarize the key lessons that you have learned in this course (Hebrew Prophetism) and explain how you are going to apply them in your ministry. (10 marks)
8. Outline the contemporary experience of "Prophets" in Africa and propose two approaches that the Church should employ to safeguard its members from the influences of false prophets. (10 marks)
