4. Explain your understanding of the word "synagogue" and give its three functions. (3 marks)
5. What are the two major reasons for the severe judgment upon Ananias and Sapphira? (2 marks)
6. State and explain six elements which show the increasingly powerful advance of the gospel (Acts 5:12-16). (6 marks)
