3. Just as there were three deportations from Jerusalem to Babylon, there were three returns from exile. Stating the years of the three returns, explain the purpose of each of the three returns? **6mks**
4. In 586 BC Nebuchadnezzar destroyed Jerusalem and the temple and took substantially all the people into captivity for 70 years. God's judgment on Judah was as complete as that of Israel. Explain the difference or the exception between Judah's captivity and Israel's captivity? **6mks**
