3. 'Man shall not live by bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.' (Matthew 4:4) Discuss the relevance of this statement as it relates to the Spiritual disciplines of Bible reading and meditation. Give two contextual examples to support your answers. (10 marks)
4. A friend of yours is faced with the dilemma of choosing someone to marry from a potential pair. Explain how you would advise them and give examples of particular factors that they should consider in making the decision. (10 marks)
5. The doctrines Christians believe should shape the way they live. Discuss this statement as it relates to corruption in society. Give two contextual examples and biblical references to support your answers. (10 marks)
6. Discuss FIVE benefits for which Christians should reclaim the discipline of fasting. Give biblical examples to support your answers. (10 marks)
