8. —The 'Righteousness of God,' includes judging justice on the one hand and then, on the other hand, the imputing and sanctifying righteousness in union with Christ received by faith.
9. —Romans chapter four expresses the importance of Abraham as the father of all believers, Jews and Gentiles
10. —A summary from Scripture of the total sinfulness of all mankind and all his works is found in Romans chapter two.
