QUESTION 1 (COMPULSORY)

Read the Case Studies below and answer the any two questions

James is 15 year old boy born to a working class family with normal pregnancy, labor and delivery. According to his mother, as an infant, James was less demanding and relatively placid and seemed different from the first weeks of life. James often seemed less interested in social interaction. He had no real friends and displayed a number of idiosyncrasies. He would often repeat phrases from the television over and over and displays a fascination with bits of strings and lint. He would collect considerable quantities of these items and would carry them around. Any time he was discouraged from carrying these items he would get agitated with periods of body rocking or head banging. James examination report suggested an usual pattern of social relatedness-making eye contact infrequently and seeming relatively uninterested in social events. He would not make use of facial expressions, gestures or body posture to regulate the interaction and lacks emotional reciprocity. His parents report that he exhibits some stereotyped behaviour when excited and tend to adhere to various non-functional routines.

- a) From the above case, identify developmental disorders that James might be experiencing?
Outline 4 characteristics of this disorder. (4 Marks)
- b) Analyse any four (4) symptoms of the condition described in the above case.
- c) Describe any two methods of managing any of the symptoms you have cited above (8 marks.)
- d) Discuss any psychological effects that the mother of James is likely to experience (4 Marks)

- b) Explain any four behaviour problems associated with children with learning disabilities? (8 Marks)
